

TGCC 2010 Rules & Policy1. Memberships Fees (Jan 1st - Dec 31st)

- Single \$ 50.00 (Individual only)
- Family \$ 80.00 (Individual + spouse+ unmarried children 25 yrs and under)

2. Green Fees:

- Member pay \$60 all matches (Except Charity Days)
- Non-member or local guest shall pay \$10.00 higher than member

3. Tee Box (for courses that has four or more tee boxes on the scorecard)

- Men ABC tee off from the second longest tee (mostly blue tee)
- Men Super Senior 65 years old, tee off from one tee box closer than Men ABC
- Lady ABC tee off from lady tee (red tee at most courses)

4. Flights and Handicap (can be adjusted later to properly balance the players in each flight)

At the beginning of the season:::

- Hdcp 0-16 = flight A
- Hdcp 17-24 = flight B
- Hdcp 25-32 = flight C

5. Competition & Reward Systema) 4 event Champions from monthly multiple matches played:

(Will earn reward points from Operating Staff)

- President Cup - winner score is from best three of four
- Consulate Cup- winner score is from best three of four
- Queen Cup - winner score is from best three of four
- King Cup - winner score is from best four of five (new this year)

Note: Must play in the last match of each tournament to qualify.

b) 4 event Champions from each charity single match played:

(Will not earn reward points from Operating Staff, .but can win prizes from Event Organizer)

- Thai Assoc charity day – winners earn prizes given by Thai Assoc
- E-Sarn charity day – winners earn prizes given by E-Sarn Assoc
- BOD Cup – winners earn prizes given by BOD-TGCC
- Dr Sam charity day –winners earn prizes from Organizer

- King's Cup... maximum hdcp = 23
- All other tournament... maximum hdcp = 25
- One day tournament, if no prior announcement, use 3 under par system as the default.
- All flight competition will use the normal hdcp (no cap)

Reward System: All Champions and Winners in each category will receive and accumulate their winning points according to the chart printed on the back of the schedule sheet. The total winning points can be redeemed for various merchandise prizes at the year-end banquet (Golf Night Party)

(Hint: point can be transferred or received only once at maximum 1000 points)

6. Tie-Breaker

- All tournament - the lower hdcp player win a tie-breaker

7. Heavy Rain Delay

- Heavy rain prior start, we must wait at least one hour after first scheduled tee time. If rain continues, the voting decision of at least 28 golfers will be final. If tie vote, the President decision will be final.
- Heavy rain during the game, we must wait at least one hour before the voting of at least 28 golfers can begin in the clubhouse.

8. Incomplete Tournament as Originally Scheduled (new for this year)

- All tournaments, if any match got cancelled due to the golf course is closed or voting decision on the storm day, the last match of each tournament will end as is scheduled with no makeup date. If the last match of the tournament got cancelled due to raining or course closed then the next match on printed schedule will be used to make up for.

9. TGCC rules are final –otherwise all USGA and Local Rules are applied to all matches.

10. TGCC SPECIAL RULE – maximum 2 balls per same water hazard and drop rule: (Please notice)

- Applied to all par3,4,5 holes that has water hazard, especially par 3 water hole ,
- If the first ball went into the water, you must either re-hit from the original spot or at the bank of the water where it last crossed. If 2nd ball went into the same water hazard again, the 3rd ball can then be dropped on the other bank of the hazard or at designated dropping area on the other side of the water bank. If no designated dropping area on the other side of the bank , player shall drop the ball on the other bank of the water hazard at the longest point away from the pin where the previous water hazard is not in the path of the next path shot. Every drop has one stroke penalty.

11. Qualification

- You have to be a current member of the TGCC in order to qualify for all the honorary trophies
- You must turned in at least 7 complete 18 holes scores from any match on TGCC printed schedule prior the King Cup tournament first match to qualify for King's Cup Championship
- Player of The Year is the Golfer who had (10) lowest net scores in the same season.

12. Hole-In-One sponsor

- First Hole-in-One win \$1000 - sponsored by Board of Directors TGCC
- Second hole-in-one win \$1000 - sponsored by key members of TGCC
- Member only except on Charity Days
