

TGCC 2009 Rules & Policy1. Memberships Fees (Jan 1st - Dec 31st)

- Single \$ 50.00 (Individual only)
- Family \$ 80.00 (Individual + spouse+ unmarried children 25 yrs and under)

2. Green Fees: (Except charity day special)

- Most members will pay between \$55 to \$65.00 as indicated on the schedule sheet
- Super Senior 65 Yrs+ will pay maximum \$ 60.00 or lower if indicated on the sheet
- Non-member or local guest shall pay \$10.00 higher than member

3. Tee Box (for golf courses that has more than three tee boxes on the scorecard)

- Men in ABC flight, tee off from the second longest tee (mostly blue tee)
- 65 years old men in C flight, tee off from third longest tee (mostly white tee)
- Lady in AB flight, tee off from white tee (same as Men Super Senior in C flight)
- Lady in C flight, tee off from fourth tee or mostly red tee

4. Flights and Handicap (can be adjusted later to properly balance the players in each flight)

At the beginning of the season:::

- Hdcp 0-16 = flight A
- Hdcp 17-24 = flight B
- Hdcp 25-32 = flight C

5. Competition & Reward System

- (5) Champions from monthly multiple matches played: (will earn points)
- (3) Champions from each charity single match played: (will not earn point)
- (1) Champion from a single match played at the end of the season (will earn points)

- King's Cup...count all 4 matchesmaximum hdcp = 23
- All other tournament...count only best 3 out of 4 matches, but must played in the last match maximum hdcp = 25
- One day tournament, if no prior announcement, use 3 under par system as the default.
- All flight competition will use the normal hdcp (no cap)

Reward System: All Champions and Winners in each category will receive and accumulate their winning points according to the chart printed on the back of the schedule sheet. The total winning points can be redeemed for various merchandise prizes at the year end banquet (Golf Night Party)

(Hint: point can be transferred or received only once at maximum 1000 points.)

6. Tie-Breaker

- All tournament - the lower hdcp player win a tie-breaker

7. Heavy Rain Delay

- Heavy rain prior start, we must wait at least one hour after first scheduled tee time. If rain continues, the voting decision of at least 28 golfers will be final. If tie vote, the President decision will be final.
- Heavy rain during the game, we must wait at least one hour before the voting of at least 28 golfers can begin in the clubhouse.

8. Incomplete Tournament As Originally Scheduled

- If any match got cancelled due to the golf course is closed or voting decision on the storm day, the tournament will end as it scheduled with no make up date, except the King's Cup Tournament, which all four matches have to be completed.

9. TGCC specified rules are final –otherwise all USGA and Local Rules are applied to all matches.

10. TGCC special rule – max 2 balls per water hazard and drop rule:

- After 2nd ball went into the same water hazard, the 3rd ball can be dropped at the course's designated dropping area. If no designated dropping area is marked, then player shall drop the ball on the other bank of the water hazard at the longest point away from the pin and the last water hazard is not in the path of the next shot. Every drop has one stroke penalty.

11. Qualification

- You have to be a current member of the TGCC in order to qualify for all the honorary trophies
- You must completed at least 7 matches prior to qualify for King's Cup Champion
- Player of The Year is the Golfer who had (10) lowest net scores in the same season.

12. Hole-In-One sponsor

- First Hole-in-One win \$1000 - sponsored by Board of Directors TGCC
- Second hole-in-one of the same player - win \$1000 sponsored by key members of TGCC
